

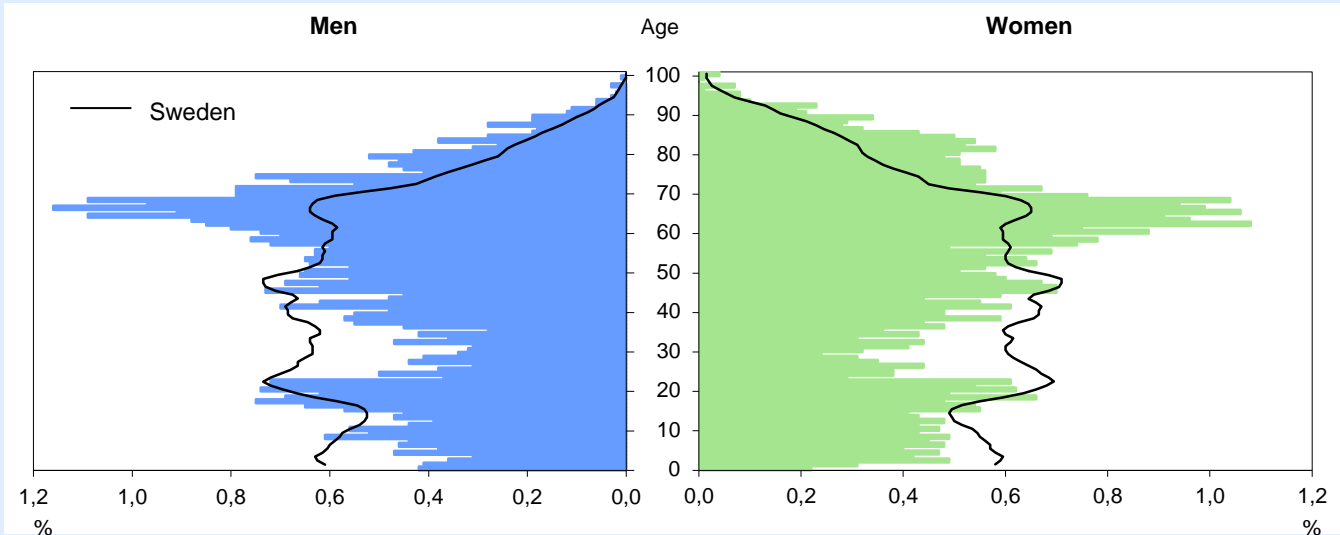

Population by age, 2012



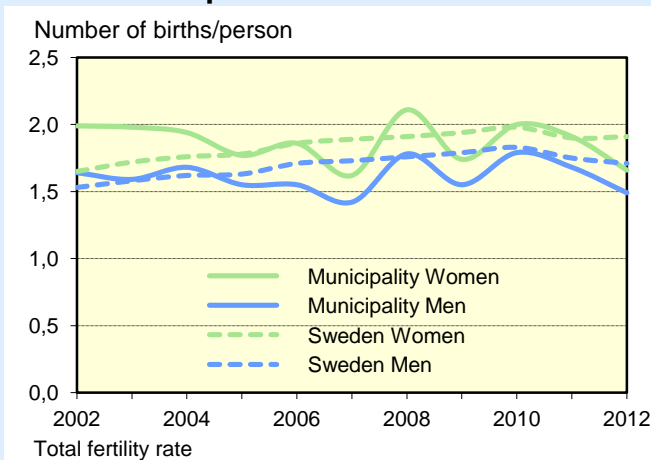

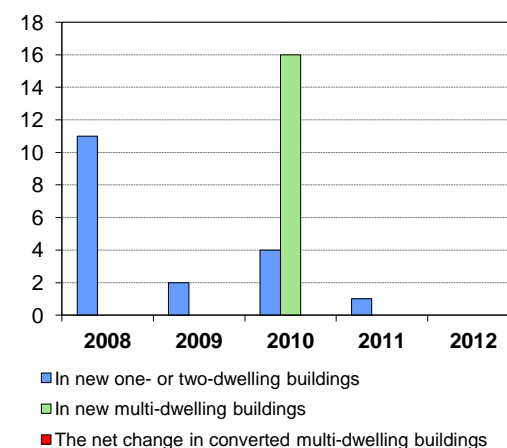

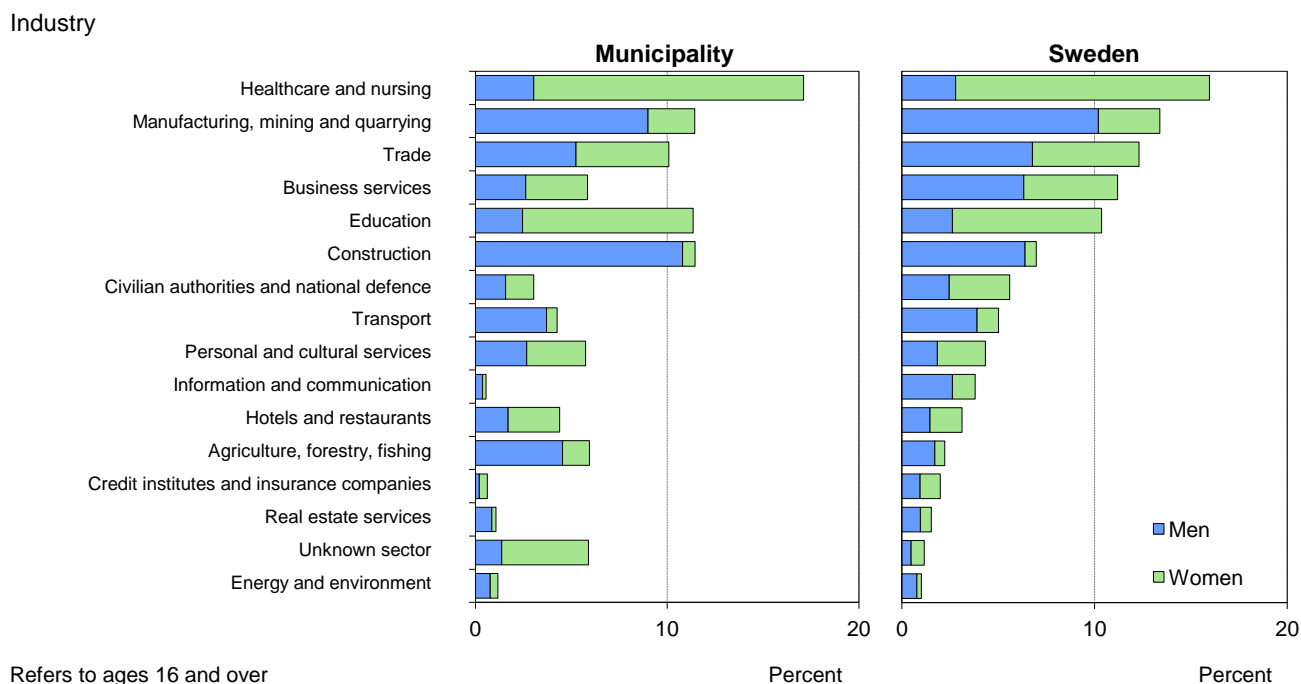

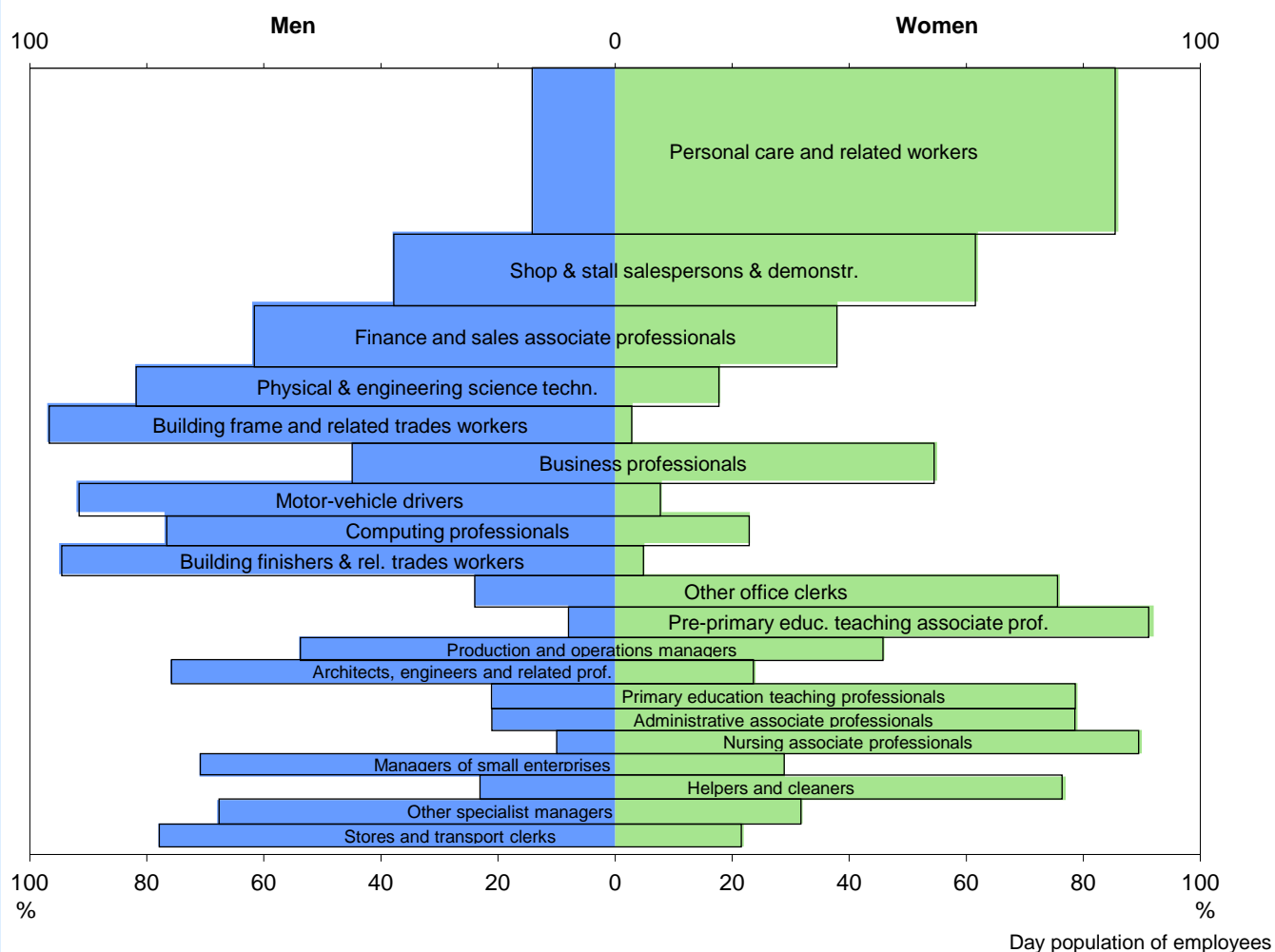

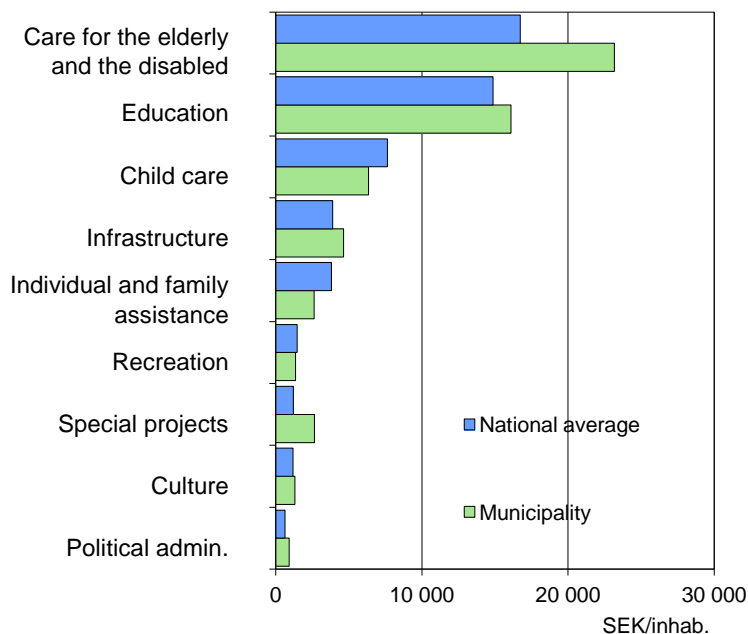
